

Sutton CC 59 Club

The 59 Club offers Sutton Cricket Club members an opportunity to help build up a fund earmarked only for Club development projects. The scheme is described below: -

Participants:

Any adult member (18-years & older) of Sutton Cricket Club may take part. A member's adult family members and/or friends may also be included.

How the 59 Club works:

Each player is allocated one or more ball number(s) between 1 and 59 inclusive, upon the club receiving the appropriate entry fee*.

Each week the player holding the same number as the Bonus Ball drawn in Saturday's National Lottery will receive a prize. This will be paid by Bacs at the end of each month in which the draw takes place.

The total prize money each week will be 30/59th of the total paid by players for that week, plus any rollover from the previous week. The winning sum will equate to 30/59ths of the amount collected, rounded down to the nearest whole £. For example, 30/59ths if there were 40 participants would be £20.

If no player holds the winning number, three-quarters of that week's prize money will rollover and be added to the following week's prize money.

* Players' Contributions:

For each ball number allocated, a player donates to Sutton Cricket Club one of following entry fee options:

Option 1: £13 for 13 weeks.

• Option 2: £25 for 26 weeks.

• Option 3: £50 for 52 weeks.
